Scholarships & Philanthropy

The Winnetka Club has supported education for many years. It is the focus of our current philanthropic efforts. Every year, we award scholarships to graduating seniors based on scholastic and community service merit, character and need. To receive a scholarship, applicants must be a U.S. citizen and either live in or attend high school in New Trier Township: New Trier High School, Loyola Academy, Regina or North Shore Country Day.

Each scholarship is paid at the beginning of the fall semester directly to the Bursar's Office at the college or university where the scholarship recipient is enrolled. Scholarships are award on a one time only basis and are not renewable.
